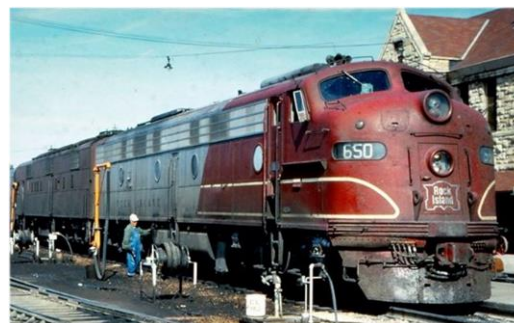

5. This is not an NMRA hosted event.

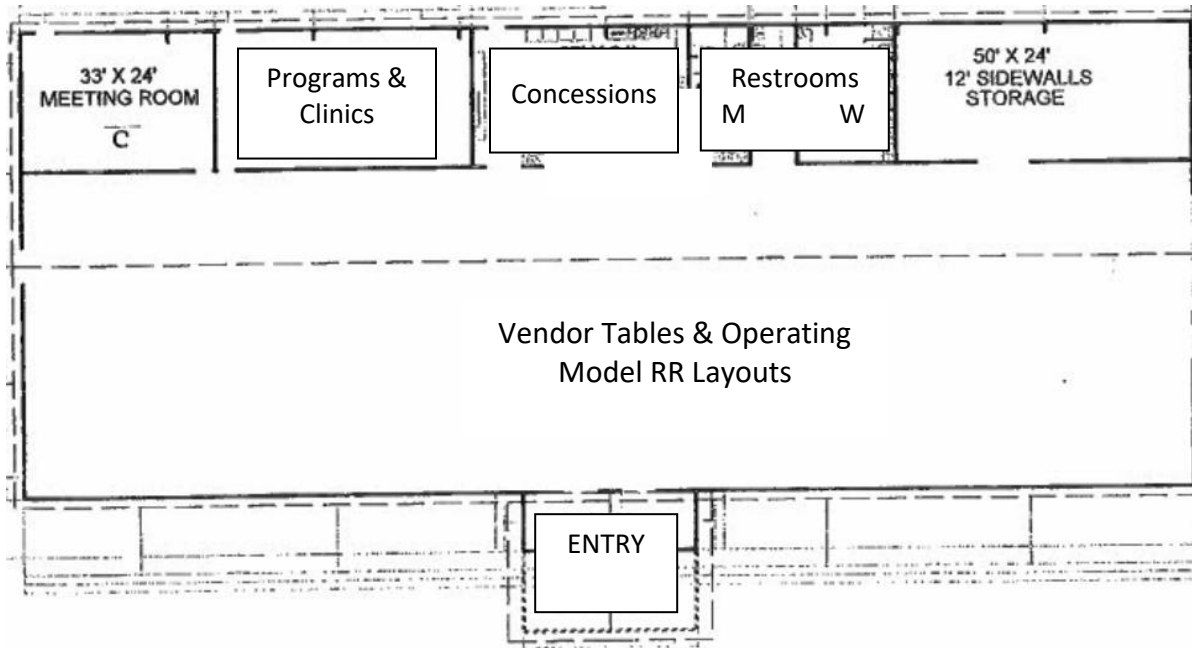
